INVOCATION

Mayor Dewayne Richters called this special called meeting to order at 6:30 P.M. and gave the invocation.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

PUBLIC HEARING

Mayor Dewayne Richters opened the Public Hearing regarding the petition requesting annexation from Wornat-Dublin, Ltd., for the property located at Lot 1, Block A, Wornat Addition, Johnson County, Texas, also known as 5601 E. Highway 67, Alvarado, Texas, at 6:38 p.m. Larry Wornat representing Stoney's Market introduced himself as the owner of the property and would answer any questions that the council had. Mayor Richters then closed the public hearing at 6:40 p.m.

CONSIDERATION AND ACTION REGARDING SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER FOR THE ALVARADO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT.

Chief Brad Anderson addressed the council and stated that AISD had approached the city and asked if they would be interested in providing an SRO officer for the school district. He explained to the council that the school district would be willing to pay ninety (90) percent of the cost for providing this

officer. This would include his salary, benefits, automobile costs including gasoline, and that during the summer months the officer would be able to work for the city. He stated that this officer would be able to give the police department more insight into what happens at the junior high and high school. Motion was made by Councilperson Tom Moore, duly seconded by Councilperson David Bayless to allow the Alvarado Police Department to provide the SRO officer for the Alvarado Independent School district. This motion supported six votes in approval and zero votes opposed. Motion carried.
