

New Sewer & Garbage Account Information for Residential Accounts (Parks of Alvarado residents only)

Welcome to the City of Alvarado! We hope this packet of information will be helpful to you.

You receive your water service from Johnson County Special Utility District and the City of Alvarado provides your sewer and garbage service. Below is detailed information about each of those services.

SEWER

Residential sewer rates are as follows: \$18.25 base rate per month and then \$4.25 for each 1,000 gallons with a cap of \$60.75. If you ever have sewer stoppage issues, please contact our office at 817-790-3351 (option #1) and City crews will respond as quickly as possible.

GARBAGE

Residential garbage is charged at a rate of \$9.22 plus tax per month and is picked up on Fridays. Please have your garbage cart(s) at the curb by 6:30 a.m. All trash must be bagged and fit within the cart that is provided and anything sitting on top of or beside the cart will not be picked up unless it is a bulk pick up week. Please refer to the reverse side of the pick-up schedule to find information about Bulk Garbage. If you need additional carts (\$7.50 per month per extra cart), please call 254-221-4418 to order. Up to two additional carts are allowed per household. Also be aware that for new construction homes it may take up to two weeks for your first cart to be delivered once you have contacted the City of Alvarado, so any trash that you have before its arrival may be placed in bags at the curb for pick up. After trash removal, all trash/recycle containers need to be stored so as not to be visible from the front of the premises.

RECYCLE

Curbside recycling service is provided to our customers at a rate of \$3.83 plus tax per month and will be picked up every two weeks (a pick-up schedule is included). All recycle materials must fit within the 95-gallon cart that is provided and should not be bagged. Residential customers may opt out of recycle services by calling City Hall if they are 65 years of age or older. If you need an additional recycle cart (\$5.00 per month), please call 254-221-4418 to order. Again, if you have moved into a new construction home and do not have a recycle cart, one should be delivered to you within two weeks.

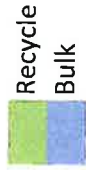

Garbage & Recycle for Residential & Commercial Hand Pick

Effective July 1, 2020

Because of the continued growth of our City, residential and commercial hand pick garbage and recycle services are being divided into two groups: Zone 1 and Zone 2.

<p>You are in <u>Zone 1</u> if your home/business is....</p> <p>North of Hwy. 67; On Chris Ct., Janis St., Helen, Liesa or Lorie</p>	<p>You are in <u>Zone 2</u> if your home/business is....</p> <p>Anywhere other than what is listed in Zone 1</p>

Each residential address will receive, free of charge, one 95 gallon cart on wheels, and each commercial hand pick account will receive two 95 gallon carts on wheels, designed to be emptied by automatic equipment. If you desire to have additional carts, you may do so for a fee of \$7.50 each per month (maximum 3 per home or business). **All ordinary garbage must be bagged and contained within the cart.** Any bagged garbage that does not fit inside the cart will be considered bulk and be picked up separately on its designated day (see chart below). These changes will not increase garbage fees.

From 35 South, Exit FM 66 (exit #8). Turn east and go 2 miles to first paved road on left.

Residents of Alvarado are allowed free access to the landfill four times per year - January, April, July and October. Free dumping is for the duration of the month, applies to any load brought by pickup truck (or trailer 6' long or less) and is limited to two dumps per month. You will be required to present your drivers license and a copy of your water bill in order to prove your residence within city limits. For residents of the Parks of Alvarado, you will be required to present your drivers license plus a letter from the City of Alvarado proving your residency since you will not have an Alvarado water bill.

Due to the size of larger trailers, they can not be safely unloaded at the front convenience station. Instead, they must be unloaded at the landfill working face located at the rear of the property. Therefore, a fee of \$10.00 per load is assessed during free dump months and \$20.00 per load any other month for any trailer longer than 6'. In addition, OSHA requires the wearing of hard hats and vests for any person accessing this area (outside of the vehicle). If citizens who bring in trailers do not have a hard hat and vest, the landfill will have them available for \$6.00 each.

The hours of operation are as follows:

Monday through Friday:	7:00 am to 5:00 pm
Saturday:	7:00 am to 12:00 pm
