That the Board of Directors of the Prairielands Public Facilities Corporation, will hold a special meeting at the Alvarado City Hall, 104 W. College, Alvarado, Texas 76009 on Wednesday May 27, 2015 at 9:00 AM for the purpose of conducting the following business:

This time is set aside for the public to address the Board on matters no listed on the Agenda. If you wish to address the Board on an Agenda item, you so do by approaching the podium as the Board considers that particular Agenda item. You will be given a reasonable amount of time to address the Board.

A special meeting and workshop will be conducted to discuss the Proposed detention and correctional center to be located in Alvarado, Texas, proposed Operations and Management Agreement by and between Prairielands Public Facilities Corporation (“PPFC”) and Emerald Correctional Management, LLC, and

the Intergovernmental Services Agreement with Immigration & Customs Enforcement, (collectively the "Project"); Discussion and action upon the following matters concerning the Project, including development, design, construction, financing, equipping, operating and maintaining the Project, the procurement processes related to the Project, and the following matters:

4. Discuss the Intergovernmental Services Agreement by and between the City of Alvarado and Immigration & Customs Enforcement related to the Project ("ICE Agreement");

5. Discuss the proposed Operations and Management Agreement by and between the Corporation and Emerald Correctional Management, LLC related to the Project ("Emerald Operations Agreement")

6. Discuss the proposed Housing Agreement by and between the Corporation and the City of Alvarado, Texas related to the Project

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Pursuant to the Texas Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code, the Public Facilities Corporation may convene in Executive Session to deliberate regarding the following matters.

a. §551.071 Consultation with Attorney The Public Facilities Corporation may convene in Executive Session to conduct a private consultation with its Attorney on any legally posted agenda item, when the Corporation seeks the advice of its Attorney about pending or contemplated litigation, a settlement offer, or on a matter in which the duty of the Attorney to the governmental body under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas clearly conflicts with the provision of Chapter 551, including the following items:

1. Any posted agenda item.

b. . §551.087 Economic Development A governmental body is not required to conduct an open meeting to discuss or deliberate regarding commercial or financial information that the governmental body has received from a business prospect that the governmental body and with which the governmental body is conducting economic development negotiations; or to deliberate the offer of a financial or other incentive to a business prospect meeting this description.
