Motion was made by Councilperson Michael Bennett, duly seconded by Councilperson Shawn Goulding, to approve an ordinance providing for the annexation into the city of Alvarado, Texas of

approximately 94.396 acres of territory described as a tract of land situated in the Hiram Lewis Survey, Abstract No. 516, Johnson County, for all municipal purposes and approve a service plan for such territory. This motion supported four votes in approval and zero votes opposed. Motion carried.

**CONSIDERATION AND ACTION REGARDING CONTRACT AWARD FOR
COTTER STREET, SPEARS STREET, AND S. CUMMINGS AVE. REPAVING.**

After discussion, motion was made by Councilperson Shawn Goulding, duly seconded by Councilperson Jacob Wheat, to award the contract for repaving Cotter, Spears and S. Cummings Streets to Reliable Paving in the amount of \$137,118.50. This motion supported four votes in approval and zero votes opposed. Motion carried.
